

In 2008, the Fellowship of Christian Athletes impacted over two million athletes and coaches for Jesus Christ another record year! More importantly, each number represents one life changed. Behind each statistic is a story of transformation—their own moment of impact.

Through the commitment of over 900 staff in 354 offices across America and thousands of volunteers and donors. lives were changed through FCA's 4 C's of Ministry: Coaches, Campus, Camp and Community. Let's celebrate the work that Christ has done through FCA in fiscal 2008!



2008 FCA Ministry Highlights

- In 2008, FCA impacted over two million individuals for the second consecutive year.
- •The 2008 FCA Camp season had 46,562 individuals participate in 266 summer camps both new records.
- FCA Sports (Sport-Specific Ministry) launched two new ministries in 2008: Skateboarding and Hockey.
- Approximately 100,000 students from over 400 locations attended our third annual Fields of Faith national event in October 2008.
- Sharing the Victory Radio Program completed its first year of broadcast and grew its reach across America from 67 to 137 stations.

- The first two books of the four-volume series on FCA's Core Values were released in 2008: Integrity and Serving. Teamwork and Excellence are due in March 2009.
- FCA distributed 182,000 Bibles in 2008 surpassing one million in the last five years.
- FCA's International Ministry impacted over 1,100 campers at 12 FCA International Camps in 2008.
- The first-ever FCA National College Conference took place in May 2008 at Lookout Mountain, Tennessee, with over 120 athletes from over 30 different colleges attending.
- FCA's new Leaders of Excellence program, a two-year spiritual leadership course, introduced its first class of 23 staff in 2008.

MINISTRY

At the heart of FCA are coaches at every level. Coaches Ministry encourages, equips and empowers coaches to know and serve Christ and coach biblically with a purpose beyond wins and losses. FCA ministers through Bible studies, Coaches Huddles, Legacy Builders, prayer, discipleship, mentoring, Behind the Bench, resources, training, outreach events, retreats and conventions. Coaches Ministry Directors School trains FCA staff to minister specifically to coaches and their families. Three classes have taken place with 26 staff members enrolled, including 13 participants in 2008.

In 2008, FCA participated in 11 national coaches' conventions where over 46,000 coaches were in attendance. Through exhibits, fellowships and worship services, hundreds of coaches made commitments to Christ and grew in their faith.

The Campus Ministry is initiated and led by studentathletes and coaches on junior high, high school and college campuses. Student-athletes grow in Christ and impact their schools through campus Huddles, team Bible studies, chapel programs, TeamFCA membership, One Way 2 Play-Drug Free, training, assemblies, Fields of Faith and other special events.

In 2008, 356,250 students were reached on 7.125 campuses across America. Additionally, this year FCA passed the half million mark for athletes signing the One Way 2 Play commitment to live and play drug and alcohol free. Also, Fields of Faith marked its third year as a national event in October 2008. An estimated 100,000 people gathered on over 400 athletic fields across 35 states to hear students share their testimonies and challenge each other to read the Word and come to faith in Jesus Christ.

FCA Camps are a time of "inspiration and perspiration" for athletes and coaches who want to reach their potential through comprehensive athletic, spiritual and leadership training. The types of camps include Sports Camp, Leadership Camp, Coaches Camp, Power/ Youth Sports Camp, Team Camp, Partnership Camp and also International Camp, which grew to eight countries in 2008.

The 2008 FCA Camp season was filled with record participation, outstanding competition and, most importantly, spiritual impact. This year, 266 camps were conducted with 46,562 people attending. Every camper was encouraged to "Get Focused" spiritually and athletically as they spent a week pursuing the goals set before them. This life-changing impact has been an integral part of FCA Camps since the first camp in Estes Park. Colorado. in 1956.

Reaching communities for Christ allows FCA to engage adults at the grassroots level through Adult Huddles, Booster Clubs and Local Boards. Also, the dramatic growth of youth sports in club teams, leagues and churches presents a significant opportunity to minister to young athletes and parents through clinics, training and outreach events. In 2008, 1,637,225 people were impacted at 34,588 FCA events. Non-school-based FCA ministries are made possible through partnerships with local churches, businesses, parents and volunteers.

FCA SPORTS (Sport-Specific Ministry) impacts specific sports communities for Christ by ministering to coaches and athletes united around a particular sport. The potential to make an impact beyond the campus is clear—an astounding 44 million youth ages 8-18 participate in organized youth sports in America.* FCA Sports provides opportunities to serve athletes and coaches in the sport(s) where their greatest passion lies. FCA Sports has established ministries for Golf, Lacrosse, Baseball, Endurance, Motocross and Health & Fitness, as well as the launch of Skateboarding and Hockey in 2008. Cheerleading and Surfing will be introduced in 2009.
